

**THE INVISIBLE MAN**

**The invisible man** is a multidisciplinary art project about the friendship and artistic collaboration between Michiel Voet and Karim Ramtani.

Karim Ramtani has been living in Amsterdam illegally, for 23 years. For a long time, he lived at the NDSM wharf where Michiel Voet's studio is located. But who is this man? How many identities does he have? Which of the stories he tells are true and which are not? For Voet, Ramtani formed a doorway to an illegal world, that he never knew existed. Together they stage photographs and reconstruct the life of Ramtani. But not only his life; Karim Ramtani leads a life that millions of other people in Europe lead. Uprooted and hidden away. This artistic reconstruction of an invisible life has been translated to an exhibition in Nieuw Dakota.

As part of this multidisciplinary project, two monumental photographs will be shown on billboards along the river IJ, the photo book will be launched during the exhibition and a theatrical performance has been developed that will premiere at the 'Over het IJ Festival' in July.
